Huge, sweet, high quality berries with good flavor, on this highly disease resistant hybrid cultivar; perfect for a trellis, edible garden, or patio containers; use a specific pruning regimen and protect from birds

Edible Qualities

Natchez Thornless Blackberry is a small shrub that is typically grown for its edible qualities. It produces clusters of black heart-shaped berries which are usually ready for picking in mid summer. The berries have a sweet taste and a juicy texture.

- Fresh Eating
- Cooking
- Baking
- Preserves
- Canning
- Freezing
